Gate Entry Policy at NEC for DHPC Race Nights

with effect from August 2018

In order to provide everyone with a fun and safe environment, the following policies will be in effect:

- ENJOY YOURSELF!
- Arrive at the gates as early as possible.
 - Drivers and Ponies are expected to arrive at NEC no later than 1 hour prior to Post Time via the bottom gate entry ramp
 - The bottom gate will be closed to restrict entry, and no spectator entry permitted. Gate close times will be as follows: 6:05pm on a Friday; 5:05pm on a Saturday and 12:05pm on Sunday or Holiday race date
 - Any trailers that are going to be late MUST call a committee member so that we can let them in/keep the gate open for them
- Lewd behaviour and language will not be tolerated, we are a family sport!
- While a list of members with Season Passes and Driver's licenses will be kept at the Top Gate for spectators entry; ALL passes MUST be presented at the gate to be allowed to use the benefit of their pass; those on gate duty are permitted to ask for your ID as well as your pass. If you do not have your pass you may be asked to pay the standard gate entry fee.
- Being a club member does not get you free entry into the races.
- Anyone entering in a truck/trailer that does not have a season pass or driver's license is expected to pay the standard gate entry fee; this can be paid at the top gate or to any Executive Committee member.

In light of this change in practice, there will be a notice to be posted on the bottom gate and the gate will be locked from the inside once all trailers are in the grounds at the above posted times.
